Macau: A Sure Bet

Visitor arrivals to Macau surpassed 20 million in 2006, a year-on-year increase of nearly 30%. More than half of these arrivals were from Mainland China (Source: Government of Macao Special Administrative Region Statistics and Census Service, December 2006, "Tourism Indicators".) as a result of (instead of "in response to") China's recent liberalization of its travel visa and currency conversion policies in combination with its (instead of "which has combined with") sustained strength in economic growth.

With all of these positive factors in play, Macau overtook the Las Vegas Strip as the largest gaming market in the world in 2006 when its gaming revenues surged 23% year-on-year to US\$6.87 billion (Source: South China Morning Post, February 12, 2007, "Macau Wrests Crown from Las Vegas").
